Resolves Conflicts Peacefully

At Free Beat Nation we believe that any conflict can be resolved peacefully and we are committed to helping you learn new ways to solve a problem before it escalates to fighting. Threats, bullying and intimidation are all considered acts of violence and are not tolerated. Violence is grounds for immediate dismissal from camp.

Respect the Personal Personal Space of Others

At Free Beat Nation we respect the personal space of others. Horseplay such as rough hugging, backslapping, snatching things from and wrestling often lead to conflict and are not allowed. We also ask that you refrain from excessive displays of affection with your friends, as those behaviors tend to make others feel excluded. We want everyone to feel included and welcomed equally.

Respect All Individuals: No Put-Downs

Free Beat Nation is a community where all individuals are honored and respected. Personal putdowns of any kind are not allowed. Disrespectful language, especially in reference to race, gender, size, sexual orientation or religion, is not acceptable.

Respect the Property of Others

Free Beat Nation is a community that relies on trust. Stealing and vandalism of camp property or the property of an individual are a serious offenses.

No Possession of Illegal Items

Possession of tobacco, alcohol, drugs, pornography and/or weapons is not only against Free Beat Nation rules, it is illegal.
